Dear Imaging Equipment Brand Owner or Other Interested Stakeholder:

It has recently come to the attention of the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) that standard format high performance ink jet printers and multi-function devices are now offered in large format as well as standard format. With this letter, EPA is notifying stakeholders that the Agency is expanding the scope of the ENERGY STAR Imaging specification to add the large format devices. These products can be tested with the existing Imaging Test Method and will be subject to the existing efficiency requirements for large format products. Table 1 in the specification and test method have been updated to include large format high performance ink jet printers and multi-function devices. This addition does not impact any existing certifications nor does it require any changes to the QPX data exchange.
