Dear ENERGY STAR® Small Network Equipment Stakeholder or Other Interested Party:

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) welcomes your input on the attached Final Draft Version 1.0 ENERGY STAR Small Network Equipment (SNE) Specification and associated documents. The documents include a draft of the SNE qualified product exchange (QPX) data entry template for review. Comments on both the Final Draft and SNE QPX template are due to EPA **no later than August 12, 2013**.

This draft incorporates input received from stakeholders in response to the ENERGY STAR SNE Draft 3 Specification. Questions and important discussion topics are highlighted in note boxes located throughout the draft specification. Minor key changes were made to clarify definitions, excluded products, and testing guidance.

EPA anticipates finalizing the SNE Specification by September 1, 2013 at which time it would become effective and products can begin being certified to the specification. Please note that to earn ENERGY STAR certification manufacturers must have their products third-party certified by an EPA-recognized Certification Body (CB) to the Version 1.0 requirements.

Stakeholders are encouraged to review the attached documents and send comments to networking@energystar.gov **no later than August 12, 2013**.
